- To manage the collection of dustbin to avoid overflow and also separation of garbage.

3. **Mr Timothy Mwangi** requested:

- The collection of waste should be done early
- Increase the number of workers to clean the town for 24 hrs
- Exhauster should work at night not day time to avoid distraction

4. **Mr Kamau Mwangi** requested:

The stolen dustbin to be replaced

- Dumpsite to be fenced

5. **Mr Maina Ngugi** requested:

- That every sub county and municipality to have its dumpsite

6. **Mrs Teresiah Wanjiru** requested:

- Mahinga residence to stop cultivating dumpsite
