#### Agendas:

1. Budget Allocation: The forum commenced with a discussion on the allocation of the municipal budget. Participants were briefed on the budgetary priorities and allocations for various sectors, including infrastructure development, social services, and environmental conservation. Minutes Of Public Participation Report on Handing over of Modern New Market to Traders & Draft Discussion of Guidelines for Market.

Venue: Karau A.C.K Hall, Ol' Kalou.

Agendas:

- 1. Handing Over of Modern New Market to Traders: The forum commenced with a discussion on the handing over of the modern new market to traders. Participants were briefed on the completion of the market construction project and the process for allocating stalls to traders. Key points raised during the discussion included concerns about fair and transparent stall allocation procedures, the provision of adequate facilities and services within the market, and measures to ensure the sustainability of the market operation.
- 2. Draft Discussion of Policy/Guidelines for Market: A draft policy/guidelines document for market management and operation was presented for discussion. The document outlined rules and regulations governing trader conduct, stall management, fee structures. and market maintenance. # MIN 01/03/2022: PRELIMINARIES

The meeting was brought to order at 10:30 a.m. by the Chairperson, the County Director of Physical Planning. He provided a summary of the assignment and the role played by the County and National Government in preparing the Ol'Kalou Local Physical and Land Use Development Plan and requested for active participation from the stakeholders.

## MIN 02/03/2022: INTRODUCTIONS/ REMARKS

The area ward administrator gave an introduction of the planning team which comprised of officials from the National Government, County Government and the National Land Commission.

The Nyandarua County Coordinator of the National Land Commission highlighted the monitoring and oversight role of the Commission and mentioned that they were engaged in stream lining Land Use Planning in Ol'Kalou town.

The Sub County administrator introduced the taskforce team and gave a brief overview of their responsibilities. He mentioned that the report provided a summary on allocated plots in Ol'Kalou including plots with and without dispute, and all public land in the area. One of the recommendations made by the taskforce report was to prepare a Plan for the town in order to promote growth and investment. The report had been submitted to the County Governor upon completion for further action.

The Municipal Manager explained to the audience the purpose of undertaking planning for the town, and mentioned that there were plans to initiate planning of the entire municipality.

John Maina, a representative of the Ol'Kalou Business Community emphasized that the revision of the town Development Plan would transform it into a commercial hub and

facilitate titling. He identified sanitation as a planning issue and the need to develop socioeconomic infrastructure for future investment.

Planner. Kenneth Nyatuongi represented the National Government planning team by providing a summary of the assignment noting that the Plan preparation necessitated collaboration between the two levels of Government, as provided by the Physical and Land Use Planning Act.

The Gachagua location chief, Zachary Chege assured the Planning Team of cooperation and requested the residents to actively participate as the Plan would benefit them.

The Chief Officer, Lands, Housing and Physical Planning introduced the County Planning team and gave remarks citing that there was need to revise the approved Development Plan of 1997 as it was no longer effective. She informed the audience that the 400 disputed plots in the town could not be addressed without updating the Plan. Additionally, the Chief Officer informed the addressees of the Nyandarua Titling and Land Program, a joint initiative with the National Land Commission which spearheaded the preparation of a County Spatial Plan, revision of the Ol'Kalou Development Plan and titling. The County Spatial Plan had since been completed and awaited approval while 4,000 titles were ready for issuance within Nyandarua County. The taskforce report recommended updating of the Development Plan to meet the demands of the growing town. She noted that the Plan would enable regularization of disputed plots and attract funding from international organizations.

The Chief Executive Committee Member for the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries Dr. James Kiraitu gave remarks on behalf of the Governor. He mentioned the ongoing projects in the town including demarcation of parking, construction of the stadium, completion of the new modern market, construction of heated pools at the arboretum and road upgrading. He noted that the town faced housing challenges due to insecurity of tenure which discouraged investors. Additionally, it was observed that there was need to promote the agricultural sector as it was a significant contributor to the economy.

#### MIN 03/03/2022: PRESENTATION

The Planning Team delivered a presentation outlining the objectives and scope of the Plan; and the expected outcomes. From the presentation and assessment of the existing situation of the town, conflict areas were highlighted.

There arose a concern from the stakeholders who claimed that planning would result to land loss which was clarified to them by the planning team.

#### MIN 04/03/2022: PLENARY

The issues raised by stakeholders after the presentation included;

- Land disputes should be addressed before undertaking planning of Ol'kalou
- The position of plots on unsurvey public utilities should be established
- The expansion of the guarry area would affect residents
- The dumpsite should be relocated away from residential zones
- The proposed site for a cemetery in Mahinga is not suitable
- Only 9 acres should be left for the functions of the arboretum
- The Plan should allocate 70 acres of land for institutions of higher learning
- Land related disputes required immediate attention
- Residents in possession of land allocated for public utilities should revert to Government
- Jerusalem and Mahinga estates lack a playground

#### MIN 05/03/2022: ADJOURNMENT

The meeting ended at 3:20 p.m. with vote of thanks from one of the stakeholders who also closed the session with a prayer.

Introduction: Ol' Kalou Municipality convened a public participation forum at ACK Church Hall to discuss budget allocation for projects and seek community input on proposed construction projects. The forum aimed to promote transparency, accountability, and community engagement in municipal decision-making processes. Additionally, the municipality emphasized the importance of gender balance, gender mainstreaming, and Gender Responsive Planning and Budgeting (GRPB) in project planning and implementation.

## Agenda:

# 1. Budget Allocation for Projects:

Moving forward, the municipality will consider resident feedback in budgetary decisions and project planning, ensuring that initiatives reflect the diverse needs and priorities of the community.
