A. FOREWORD

The 2026 County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSP) has been prepared with an intention to catalyze the already initiated development transformative agenda for the County. The current County administration initiated various interventions aimed at uplifting the livelihoods of the residents across all the sectors. The theme for the 2026 Budget is a *Change Agenda For Social- Economic Development And Wealth Creation* aimed at uplifting the livelihoods of Nyandarua residents.

The Budget process for FY 2026/27 commenced in August 2025 with the issuance of the Budget Circular by the CECM for Finance outlining all the steps and stages leading to this point and ultimately the Budget for FY 2026/27. In September 2025, the Annual Development Plan (ADP) which outlined the priorities for the various departments for FY 2026/27, ensuring alignment with the County's development objectives was prepared and approved by the County Assembly in January 2026. Further, in September 2025, the County Budget Review and Outlook Paper (CBROP 2025) which gave us the broad sector ceilings was prepared forming the foundation for the County Fiscal Strategy Paper and the upcoming budget for FY 2026/27.

In line with Section 117 of the PFMA, the CFSP was developed which will inform the allocations to various programmes for the 2026/27 FY. The said law requires that public participation be conducted when preparing and finalizing the CFSP.

It is with respect to the constitutional and PFM requirements that the public participation was held on 19th February, 2026 in ten sub county venues reaching a total of over 1,000 participants drawn from the elderly, women, youth, PWDs, farmers, religious community, business community among others.

I take this opportunity to commend all the people who participated in this process.
